Licenses are available year round and expire at the end of the month of the rabies vaccination anniversary.

Male or Female, neutered/spayed	\$ 15.00
Male or Female, not neutered/spayed	\$ 45.00
Delinquent neutered/spayed	\$ 30.00
Delinquent, not neutered/spayed	\$ 90.00
Three year, neutered/spayed	\$ 35.00
Three year, not neutered/spayed	\$125.00
Delinquent three year, neutered/spayed	\$ 68.00
Delinquent three year, not neutered/spayed	\$240.00

Puppies that turn 4 months old and newly acquire older dogs are eligible for licenses at the non-delinquent rate if the license is purchased within 30 days of their becoming 4 months old or of being acquired. Dog license renewals purchased prior to the expiration of the license also qualify for the non-delinquent rate. Non-delinquent one-year licenses may be pro-rated if fewer than 6 months remain in the licensing period. There is no pro-rated three-year license and no refunds for any unused portions.

RABIES VACCINATION:

Check with your veterinarian to be sure that the rabies vaccination is current. You must send the original rabies certificate with this application. The certificate will be returned with your new license. A three-year rabies vaccination is required for a three-year license.

NEUTER CERTIFICATE:

A veterinarian's certificate of sterilization is required for the neutered license. You must send the original neuter certificate with this application. The certificate will be returned with your new license.
